Sub: Regarding some operation related issues and pending grievances of executives in Rajasthan circle.

Respected Sir,

We would like to express our solicit gratitude and request to kindly look into the issues as detailed below:

**1. Disconnection of power supply of BTSs and exchanges by electricity department:**

The power supply of BSNL BTS and exchange is being disconnected by electricity department due to nonpayment of electricity bill by BSNL. As per feedback received from field, previously the supply was not being disconnected due to personal liasoning of our field executives but now the target of revenue realization has been assigned by Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited companies to their field executives so they are disconnecting the power supply. To maintain availability of BTSs and exchanges our field staff is running generator by purchasing diesel from his pocket. In this regard a meeting may be organised at appropriate level for relaxation to BSNL (As fully Govt. owned PSU) for some time for not disconnecting the power supply of our BTSs and exchanges meanwhile the fund may be arranged for payment of these pending bills.

**2. Reimbursement of outdoor medical claims for medicines with generic names:**

**Medical Council of India (MCI) has notified an amendment in Clause 1.5 of Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations, 2002 vide notification dated 21.09.2016, which stipulates that "Every physician should prescribe drugs with generic names legibly and preferably in capital letters and he/she shall ensure that there is a rational prescription and use of drugs". MCI has further issued a circular on 21.04.2017 vide which all the Registered Medical Practitioners under the Indian Medical Council (IMC) Act have been directed to comply with the aforesaid provisions.**

As per this notification many doctors are writing generic names of medicines in place of actual name in his prescription. But chemist writes the actual name of medicine in his bill. Due to this discrepancy the amount of these medicines are being deducted from reimbursement claims of executives while passing the same. You are requested to issue suitable instructions regarding approval of these types of cases after collecting sufficient proof of medicines.

### **3. Request of Sh. Deshraj Gujar JTO Ajmer for change of posting station from Sirohi-TD to Bhilwara-TD:**

As per CGMT office letter no. STA/8-15/JTO/RR/2018/Part-33 dated 21/12/2018, the own cost transfer request of Sh. Deshraj Gujar from Ajmer-TD to Jaipur-TD was registered in request register on 13/03/2018 at Sr. No. 22. But his name was removed from request register as per CGMT office letter STA/8-5/GB/Exe/Genl/2017-18/14 Dated 03/03/2020 without any reason.

Again as per request of our association vide letter dated 13/03/2020 his request for transfer was modified from Jaipur-TD to Bhilwara-TD which is registered at Sr. No. 84 as per CGMT office letter No. STA/8-5/GB/Exe/Genl/2017-18/20 dated 06/06/2020. Now he has been transferred to Sirohi-TD vide CGMT office letter no. STA/8-15/Ch.17/RTFR/JTO/2020/4 Dated 10/06/2020.

Further, His wife is working as teacher in Kekri Ajmer. Previously his femur is also fractured while working on duty and road is implanted for support.

Considering all above facts you are requested to revise his posting order from Sirohi-TD to Bhilwara-TD as per his request. There are already two own cost requests registered in request register for transfer from Pali-TD to Sirohi-TD and from Bhilwara-TD to Ajmer-TD which may be entertained.

### **4. Preparation of gradation list of JTO/JAO:**

It is learnt that in Rajasthan circle, the provisional seniority/gradation list of JTOs is not prepared since 01/06/2010. There have been many changes in this gradation list in last ten years and post VRS-2019 scenario. Due to non-availability of gradation list many executives who are on deputation to other circle were not included in AIEL of JTO to SDE promotion. Similarly the gradation list of JAOs is also not prepared from long time. In this regard we have requested earlier vide our letter dated 18.06.2020 & 30.10.2020 to publish the gradation list of JTO and JAO. You are once again requested to arrange for preparation of gradation list of JTOs and JAOs for promotion in future.
