Sub: -Regarding discrepancies found in the inter-circle hard tenure station transfer orders.

Ref: -BSNLCO-PRII/19(11)/5/2021-PERS-II Dated 20.07.2021

As per above cited subject the order of hard tenure transfer were issued vide above referred letter. Many discrepancies are found in this order as mentioned below:

1. The executives from hard tenure station are allotted CN (TX) instead of their choice of station.
2. Three executives at Sr. No. 5,6,8 are allotted to CN (Tx-North) and they are supposed to be posted in CN (Tx) Punjab circle.
3. In place of these, three executives at Sr.No. 2,9,11(which belongs to NTR-Rajasthan) are transferred from CN (Tx-North) to CN (Tx-East), NE-1, WBTC respectively. Thus no executives are posted in Rajasthan and three executives are transferred out of Rajasthan. If executives are joining in a circle then executives from that circle only should be transferred.
4. While issuing these transfer orders the longest stay of SDEs in Rajasthan territorial circle is not considered. In case of Sh Rajeev Kulshresth at Sr. No. 11, He is at 14th no. in stay in Rajasthan circle. He has been transferred to WBTC while executives longer stay than him in Rajasthan circle are not transferred.
5. If the stay is counted in CN (Tx-North) only, then stay in all circle which are included in CN (Tx-North) should be counted and then executives of longest stay should be considered.

You are requested to look into the matter and arrange for cancellation of transfer order of Sh. Sh Rajeev Kulshresth.
